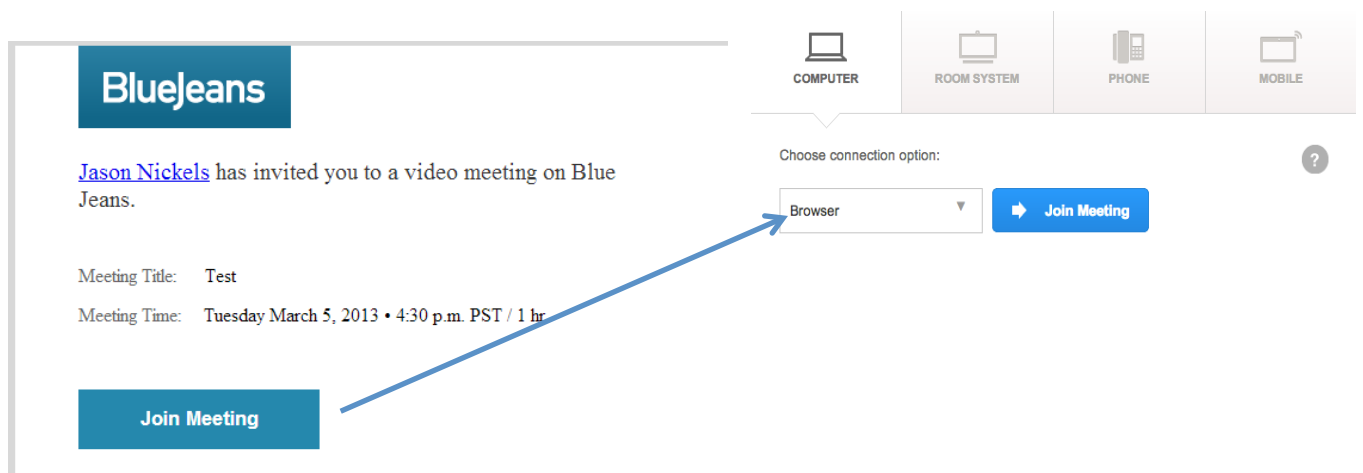


# Join Blue Jeans from Browser

**STEP 1:** Click the Join Meeting link in the Blue Jeans email invite.

**STEP 2:** Choose Browser and click the Join Meeting button from your connection page. (If prompted, install the browser plug-in). Select Enter Meeting to start or join the meeting.

- Can't install the browser plugin? Check if you have Symantec Endpoint Protection installed. (See Knowledge Base for [instructions to update settings](#) to allow plugin installation.)
- Still can't install the plugin? Are you using a Mac on OS X Mountain Lion? (See Knowledge Base for [instructions to set Blue Jeans as trusted application](#) to allow plugin installation).



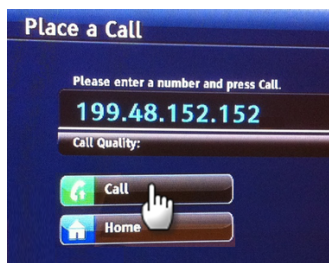
# Join Blue Jeans from Primary Room System using Meeting ID

**STEP 1:** Click the Room System tab in the Meeting Connect Panel to expand the dialing instructions.

**STEP 2:** Per the first instruction, from your Room System monitor dial the listed IP address (for convenience, save this IP to the directory).

**STEP 3:** Blue Jeans delivers you into your room system monitor, an input field for Meeting ID and Passcode, and displays a “pairing” code at the bottom. Enter the Meeting ID from the invite using your remote.

- If unable to connect, ensure all ports listed in Security data sheet are not blocked and that the room system is capable of dialing outbound to a public IP address.
- Visit <http://bluejeans.com/demo> if conducting the test without other parties, to use as a participant.

# Join from iPhone or iPad

Before you start:

- STEP 1:** Download [Blue Jeans App](#) in iTunes on iPhone or iPad
- STEP 2:** Open Blue Jeans App
- STEP 3:** You can then log in or simply enter the meeting ID and passcode to join

Logging in also allows you to:

Start a new meeting: Click Instant Meeting to create your own

View existing meetings: Click “Calendar” tab at the bottom left of your app (displayed side by side on iPad)
