Take I-95 north to 135 Street. Head east to U.S. 1 (Biscayne Blvd.) Head north to 151 Street. Turn right. Follow the road east and the campus will appear on the left. The Kovens Conference Center will be the last driveway entrance, passing the entrance of the University.

From Ft. Lauderdale:

Take I-95 south to 826 East. Head east to U.S. 1. (Biscayne Blvd.) Head south to 151 Street. Turn left. Follow the road east and the campus will appear on the left. The Kovens Conference Center will be the last driveway entrance, passing the entrance of the University.



Map of Biscayne Bay Campus






Kovens Conference Center Floor Plan

Second Floor





Coral Castle Museum 28655 S Dixie Hwy Homestead, FL 33033

Coral Castle is a stone structure created by the Latvian American eccentric Edward Leedskalnin (1887–1951) north of the city of Homestead, Florida.





Vizcaya is a European-style estate built by a wealthy

American industrialist in the early 20th century that's home to 34 immaculately decorated rooms, over 2,500 pieces of art, ten acres of European-inspired formal gardens, a collection of over 2,000 orchids, and 25 acres of endangered primary growth forests.

The Museum of Discovery and Science has contributed

significantly to the revitalization of the arts and sciences district in downtown Fort Lauderdale. Consisting of 119,000 square feet of interior space, the 300-seat AutoNation IMAX Theater, and an open-air grand atrium, the Museum features dynamic interactive exhibits in the natural and physical sciences and a large array of programs designed to serve diverse audiences.
